Welcome to the Branding and Style guide for the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide. This document outlines the positioning and design guidelines for our various logos. The contents of these guidelines cover all elements of the brand required for its consistent and most effective application. These guidelines were created for employees of Diocesan Office, but we hope it is helpful for others too.

It is through this guide we ensure the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide presents itself consistently and professionally, and that you have the appropriate know-how and tools to produce communication that meet these standards.

These guidelines should act as the first point of reference for all those involved in the development of communication material for the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide or any material that bears one or more of it's logos.

This Branding and Style Guide is a living, breathing document. It is important to note that these guidelines will expand, evolve and change over time. Please ensure that you are using the most up to date version.





Logo Elements

The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide logo is a visual representation of the brand, and its integrity must be maintained at all times.

The logo is comprised of the Diocesan shield and logotype custom set in Helvetica Neue light. These two elements are separated by a narrow 'Blue Bar' that exceeds the height of the Diocesan Shield.

Logo Safe Zone

The integrity of the brand is important, therefore the defined safe zone maximises our visual presence.

The safe zone is a defined area around the logo where no other graphical element, such as text or imagery may intrude into.

- This area (X) is equal to the height between the base of the logotype and the base of the 'Blue Bar'.
- The 'X' height changes proportionally to the size of the logo.

Colour Specifications

Using a consistent colour palette helps build brand awareness and recognition.

The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide colour palette consists of four primary colours. For consistency, only use the exact colour specifications outlined here.


For Printed material, use the 4-colour process (CMYK) breakdown for each colour. For on-screen applications use the RGB or HEX breakdown.

Logo Versions

The full colour logo is the preferred version; it should be used whenever possible.

On occasions where there are colour restrictions or it is impractical to use the logo in full colour, please use the mono black option.

Both versions of the logo are available in vector format (Adobe Illustrator EPS), which may be scaled up or down to a desired size without compromising image quality.

Secondary Colour Palette

A range of seconday colours have been specified to support the primary palette. These colours can be used to add personality to designs and to differentiate between communication items.

Avoid using too many seconday colours on any design.

Incorrect Use

To maintain the integrity of the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide logo, and to promote the consistency of the brand, it is important to use the logo as described in these guidelines.

The examples shown here illustrate possible misuse of the logo that should be avoided.

- (a) Do not stretch, compress or distort the shape of the logo.
- (b) Do not alter the colour of any part of the shield or logotype.
- (c) Do not add any graphic style or embellishments to the logo.i.e drop shadows, strokes, inner or outer glow.
- (d) Do not place the logo on a high contrast, coloured or textured background or photograph.
- (e) Do not place text or imagery within the safe zone of the logo.
- (f) Do not alter the logo typeface.
- (g) Do not rotate, invert or pivot the logo.
- (h) Do not change the proportions or rearrange the elements of the logo.
- (i) Do not change the opacity or use the logo as a watermark.

Size & Scaling

- To maintain print legibility, it is recommended that the logo be reproduced no smaller that 12mm in height.
- Do not make the logo smaller than 50px high in digital executions.
- The height of the logo is measured by the height of the narrow blue bar the separates the shield and the logotype.
- · There is no maximum recommended size.
- Ensure a width to height ratio of 20:7 is maintained when scaling the logo.

Co-branding

- When the logo needs to sit alongside an additional supporter or partner logo, size, placement and relevance need to be considered. The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide logo should always be placed on the left or on top.
- When placed horizontally, the logos should have their centre points aligned vertically.
- When placed vertically, logos will be aligned by their left edges.
- The logos should be of the same visual size and a proper safe zone (X) needs to be maintained around each logo.

Print Fonts

Helvetica Neue is the primary typeface selected for the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide.

 Only four weights of Helvetica Neue should be used (each with an italic): Light, Regular, Medium and Bold.

Minion Pro has been selected as our seconday typeface. Minion Pro can be used in conjunction with the primary typeface or by itself where it is more appropriate to use a serifed font.

- In all communication material, the minimum size that type should be set at is 8.5pt. Only disclaimers, footnotes and some stationary text should be a smaller type size.
- If a document is being professionally set by an in-house designer or external agency - the font size may be smaller and more font weights may be applied, however, legibility must be considered.
- Arial and Times New Roman are to be used as substitute fonts where Helvetica and Minion Pro are not available.

Logo Positioning

Consistent positioning of the logo is a very important part of our design language.

- The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide logo should always be positioned either in the top left or bottom left of the page. In some situations, the logo may be aligned to the centre of the page, this should only be considered by a professional in-house designer or external agency.
- The logo should try to be an equal distance from the two closest edges whilst maintaining the appropriate safe zone (X) around the logo.


PowerPoint Templates

Photography and graphs can be added to the templates to add visual appeal.



Diocesean Shield

Using the Diocesan Shield separately

Size & Scaling

To maintain print legibility, it is recommended that the Shield be reproduced no smaller that 12mm in height.

Do not make the Shield smaller than 50px high in digital executions.


Ensure a width to height ratio of 3:4 is maintained when scaling the Shield.

Safe Zone

The safe zone around the Shield is equal to the height of the horizontal blue section of the shield. No other graphical element such as text or imagery may intrude into this space.


Page Positioning

When the Shield is used in place of the Diocesan logo, the Shield should always be aligned to the centre of the page, either in the top or bottom third of the page. Care should be given to make sure that the Shield is not placed too close to the top edge of the page.






Size & Scaling

To maintain print legibility, it is recommended that the logo be reproduced no smaller that 14mm in height.

Do not make the logo smaller than 50px high in digital executions.

Ensure a width to height ratio of 1:1 is maintained when scaling the logo.

Logo Versions

The Bishops Mitre is available in full colour and greyscale versions.

Safe Zone

The safe zone around the Mitre is equal to the height of the triangle created in the negative space of the Mitre. No other graphical element such as text or imagery may intrude into this space.



Web & Social Media


The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide shield has been rotated and cropped to a square to create the social media avatar.

Adelaide Anglicans Avatar







